REGARDING: Maximum Rate Tariff Training Seminar

The transportation of household goods (HHG) over public highways within North Carolina is under the jurisdiction of the North Carolina Utilities Commission (NCUC). The Maximum Rate Tariff (MRT) issued by the NCUC governs the rates and service practices associated with these shipments. The provisions of the MRT define the maximum rates that can be charged, describe the rules under which HHG carriers operate, and stipulate the forms which must be used.

To ensure carriers are familiar with the provisions of the MRT, **free** training seminars are provided as a joint effort by the NCUC, the Public Staff, and the North Carolina Movers Association (NCMA). These seminars provide employees the opportunity to undergo training that is beneficial to overall business operations. At the end of the day, sample moves are provided to the attendees to apply their newfound knowledge in a relaxed, cooperative atmosphere. Instructors are available to answer questions and help attendees perfect appropriate billing practices. Such "hands on" opportunities have been praised by carriers who have sent new employees to subsequent seminars.

ATTENDEES NEED TO BRING A COMPLETE, CURRENT COPY OF THE MRT. The date in the lower right-hand corner of Page 45 should show an effective date of January 1, 2019. We will be using the MRT as the text for the seminar.
