Report to the Board - Military

Continuing issues since last report on 17 September 2016:

-DPS System functionality. SDDC continues to have some systemic and unprogramed outages. As a consequence, USTRANSCOM directed a "Deep Dive Review" of the system directed at answering questions generated by the following statement: "The DoD's end-to-end household goods value chain lacks the unity of effort and alignment required to consistently produce high quality relocation services for Service members and their Families." It will focus on the areas of Accountability, Family Relocation DP# management, Entitlements and Automation. The aggressive timeline calls for implementation of solutions by February 2017.

-Rate filing for the 2017 rate cycle will open in January with the following dates for Rounds 1 and 2:

Round 1 opens 8 Jan and closes 13 Jan

- Round 2 opens 3 Feb and closes 11 Feb
