1st Quarter 2024 Military Committee Update

DPS annual rate filing

Round 1: 18 February 24 (6:00 PM CST) – 23 February 24 (6:00 PM CST)

New provision in Advisory 24-0031 states that “TSPs must file bids on the appropriate Market, Code of Service, and channel in Rd1 to file bids in Rd2”.

Army storing soldier’s belongings

Effective 1 Oct 23, the Army has ended a major program that allowed soldiers to store their HHG’s and POV’s while they are away from home for extended periods of time. Army Sustainment Command, which oversees logistics for the Army, discontinued the use of funds across the service to store vehicles and other goods owned by soldiers while they are deployed. Army planners are drafting a policy that would enable storage at no cost to soldiers. It is not clear whether funding was discontinued for all types of deployments or only for soldiers on temporary duty (TDY). In the meantime, soldiers are authorized to store their vehicles in motor pools.

GHC Update

Al Thompson “stepped down” as CEO of HomeSafe Alliance on or around 19 December 23. Bobby Nicholson, VP of Operations at KBR was appointed new CEO effective 1 January 24.

USTRANSCOM announced in early January that an information systems technology glitch has delayed implementation of the GHC contract. MilMove and HomeSafe Connect must be fully compatible and integrated before TRANSCOM will begin awarding shipments under GHC.
